Activist joins Dalyellup fight

CONCERNED Dalyellup residents have welcomed a renewed focus on the battle to end the dumping of radioactive materials in their neighbourhood as US health crusader Erin Brockovich investigates claims that residents' lives are being put at risk.

The environmental activist and Australian law firm Shine Lawyers will investigate whether residents have grounds to sue for damages.

Shine Lawyers executive director Simon Morrison will be visiting the site in coming months to investigate claims further.

"I can confirm that Shine Lawyers are investigating the two cases in Esperance and Dalyellup," Mr Morrison said

Concerned Dalyellup resident David Yeoman said increased publicity would help expose the issue.

"If you don't ask questions, you don't get answers," Mr Yeoman said.
